We will travel to the original Fort Boise site on the Snake River, to the Oregon Trail interpretive site on Highway 201, along Lytle Blvd. to Vale, Oregon, with stops at the Keeney Pass interpretive site and the John D. Henderson grave. Lunch will be at the Vale City Park. The Stone House Museum will be open for people to visit.
